**Entry Fee:** Hunter & Equitation Classes: \$25.00 per class  
Stake Classes: \$30  
All Jumper Classes: \$30  
\$5.00 add back to jumper and stake classes  
Per entry (50%, 30%, 20% for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup>)

**Stabling:** \$75.00 weekend (Fri – Sun)  
\$55.00 overnight(arriving after 4 pm previous  
Day and showing one day)  
\$40.00 Day stall  
\$50.00 Paddock weekend  
\$35.00 Paddock overnight  
All stalls include shavings  
**Stabling is limited. Full payment for stalls  
Required as a deposit to hold stalls. Deposits  
Refunded only if vacancies are filled. Deposit  
Checks not cashed until after show.**

**Pine Hill, Hunt Farm, Ruth Sawin, Pamela Hunt, Show Management, or GHHJA** will not be responsible for any loss or damage or injury to persons, horses or property. Each minor exhibitor *must* have parent, guardian or trainer sign the release incorporated in the entry form. **Also----EVERYONE MUST SIGN A RELEASE FORM (INCORPORATED IN THE ENTRY BLANK) BEFORE RIDING ON FRIDAY. EVERY HORSE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS MUST HAVE A SIGNED ENTRY BLANK FILED WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY.** Entry blanks are at the secretary's area (or online) to be completed *before* you ride.

All riders and trainers of horses and ponies in this show must be members in good standing of the GHHJA or pay a non-member fee. Horses and ponies competing for end of year awards must be registered. Membership dues are \$275 for Lifetime, \$45 for seniors (18 years and older), \$40 for Juniors (under age of 18), Owner/parent/other (age 18 or older) \$35 and horse/pony registration is \$45 Lifetime or \$15 annual. Dues must be paid to show secretary (check made payable to GHHJA) or proof of membership and horse/pony registration must be submitted before showing in order to earn points. The owner must check GHHJA database to make sure name is not being used. A non-member rider or non-member trainer may participate after paying the show secretary a "non-member fee" of \$12 per entry on a one time basis per show. Lead Line division is exempt from any membership fees.

**Protective Headgear is required for all riders while mounted on a horse on the show grounds. All exhibitors must wear a harness hat approved in accordance with the USEF rules.** In all Classes, except for the warm-up classes, riders must wear shirts with collars and either boots and breeches or paddock boots and jodhpurs in order to show.

Coggins Regulations: Proof of negative coggins (drawn within the last 12 months) is required for all horses.

Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses, or do anything necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. USEF rules prevail unless otherwise stipulated.

**All entries must be secured by an open signed check at the time of registration.** Make checks payable to **Pine Hill**. \$50 processing fee for all non-negotiable checks.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES during show hours. No bad dogs allowed.

All Junior riders (18 and under) participating in an over fences class must have a trainer, parent, or responsible party (over the age of 18) at ringside while that rider is participating in that over fence class.

In order to compete in a stake class a horse/pony must compete in at least one other fence class in the division.

**Three** riders must be entered before start of Medal class for class to be held.

**ONLY Walk/Trot, Pre-Beginner and Beginner classes will be held up for Trainer conflicts.**
